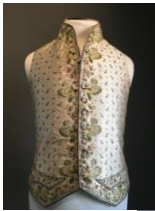

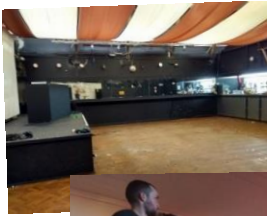
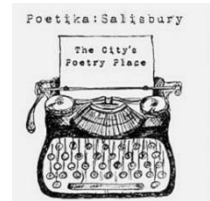

Fringe favourites Poetika return with another eclectic mix of poetry and spoken word pieces



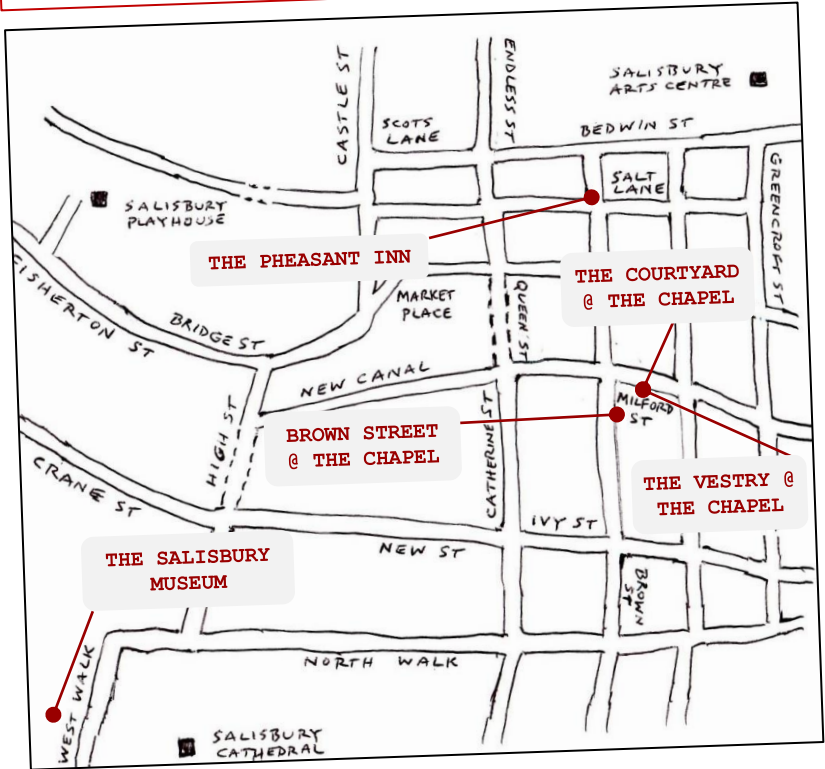
SUNDAY SCRATCH Brown Street at The Chapel 3.30-5.00pm
